

Wells County 4-H Park Log Cabin



Plans are underway to make some needed repairs and restoration to the 1855 4-H Park Log Cabin.

Originally built by English immigrant, John Bennett on a farm 3 1/2 south west of Bluffton. The cabin was then moved to the 4-H Park location in 1961.

Today it provides a rustic location for outdoor education programs hosted at the 4-H Park for youth activities and during the annual 4-H Fair. It also serves as the backdrop for the pioneer encampment during the Wells of Yesteryear Antique Power Show each August.

The cabin has also been featured twice on the Christmas House Walk and is a very popular location for graduation and wedding photographs.

Our fund raising efforts are underway to raise \$26,000 so that the work can be completed.

A special donor sign is being planned for the restoration project. The sign will proudly display the names of the donors.
