in.4HOnline.com and enter your family profile. You
will need to know the email address and password you
used to set up your family profile. Then you may go
into projects and edit the projects you have already
chosen and either delete or add projects.

However, once you do this, you must let the Extension Office know if you have added a project. You will need to come to get your record sheets, manual and any other required curriculum. We are not automatically informed by the system if you drop or add a project. In addition, if you have dropped a project and no longer need a manual, please return it to the Extension Office.

The animal identification with the 4-H Online system requires a Premise ID number for all cattle, sheep, swine, and goats. This number is assigned to a farm location almost like an address. 




